Alpine Chic and a Wine Tower at Zurich Airport

The new Radisson SAS Hotel at the Zurich airport may almost make you wish for a canceled flight. It has a sleek design, Europe's tallest wine tower, a six-story-high lobby and a restaurant with an open kitchen and an Alpine-chic look.

The hotel has four different designs for its 330 rooms and suites: At Home (simple and warm), Chic (carpeting with black lines and Bordeaux-colored furniture), Fresh (cheerful colors) and Charm (one-bedroom suites with black Polder sofas by the Dutch

designer Hella Jongerius and pink-colored sideboards by the Italian designer Matteo Thun, whose firm was responsible for the overall look of the hotel).

The Angels' Wine Tower Grill has the 45-foot wine tower, which holds over 4,000 bottles that can be accessed via acrobatic servers. The hotel, across from Terminal One, is the only hotel with a direct link to the Zurich airport. Starting nightly rates: 215 francs, or about \$175, at 1.24 francs to the dollar; www.RadissonSAS.com.
